NEW PHILADELPHIA, Ohio (February 4, 2019) – The 10th annual Taste of Tusc, a fundraiser for the Ohio & Erie Canalway and Towpath Trail, is taking place Friday, March 15, at the Performing Arts Center at Kent State Tuscarawas.

Taste of Tusc, an event held by the Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition, welcomes hundreds of guests annually to sample food, dessert, wines, and beers from a variety of local vendors.
